Personal Social Emotional Development

Objectives

Activities

- Explain own knowledge and ask appropriate questions of others.
- Confident to speak to a group about own needs, wants and interests,
- Begin to negotiate and solve problems without aggression- e.g. when someone has their toy.
- What do we know about sharks/dolphins etc- and what do we want to find out?
- Circle times- holidays, favourite things etc.
- Rule discussions and implementing using our class rules in provision- children solving their own problems.



Communication and Language

Objectives

Activities

- Maintain attention and concentrate during appropriate activity
- Listen and respond to ideas expressed by others in conversation and discussion
- Extend vocabulary especially by grouping and naming, exploring the meaning and sounds of new words.
- Watch information/movie clips linked with the topic- can children talk about what they have watched/seen?
- Chatty partner training- children to chat about different simple subjects linked with the topic and feedback to others.
- Look at information books about sea creatures and talk about any new words and their meaning.

Expressive Art and Design

Objectives

Activities

- Use simple tools and techniques competently and appropriately
- Select tools and techniques to shape/assemble/join materials they are using.
- Understand different media can be combined to create new effects
- Play cooperatively as part of a group to act out a narrative,
- Clay modelling- sea creatures- fish/crabs/sharks etc.
- Collaging sea creature/beach items using a range of materials and media
- Junk modelling
- Rock pool plate/seaside's in a shoe box.
- Act out stories/poems linking to topic.

Physical Development

Objectives

Activities

- Practice some appropriate safety measures without direct supervision.
- Use a pencil and hold it effectively.
- Experiment with different ways of moving.
- Show control over mark making tools
- Writing and pre writing activities- painting, brushing, writing in sand,/with sticks etc.
- Move like the different sea creatures
- Healthy summer snack making- fruit/veg and importance of healthy eating
- Forest school- safety and independence
- Dance based activities- movement in response to music

Literacy

Objectives

Activities

- Using phonics to read- initial sounds, phase 2,3, 4 and 5 phonics.
- Demonstrate understanding when talking about what they have read.
- Use vocabulary and forms of speech influenced by their experience of books
- Know information can be retrieved from books
- Writing- phonemes, labels, captions, sentences and forms of narrative.
- Reading seaside related texts- fiction and non fiction.
- Drawing and labelling sea creatures
- Writing fact sheets about sea creatures
- Story mapping and innovating stories (talk for writing)
- Acting out stories
- Chatty partner skills- discussions with our friends about different topics.

Maths

Objectives

Activities

- Recognise numerals 1-5 then to 10.
- Adding and subtracting- using language of then pictorial representation then using numbers sentences
- Solving mathematical problems
- Record using marks, pictures then numbers
- Estimate by guessing then checking afterwards
- Use language of money and begin to add money
- Measure periods of time in simple ways
- Matching amount of sea creatures to numbers
- Estimating how many shells in a rock pool
- Under the sea addition and subtraction
- Trip- counting how many different creatures we see
- Sea/beach problems
- Paying for ice creams/lollies or buckets and spades in seaside shop

Activities

- Complete a simple program on a computer/engage with appropriate ICT software
- Recognise technology and its uses
- Know similarities, differences in relation to places, objects, materials and living things
- Know about similarities and differences between themselves and others.

- Trip to sea life centre- finding out about sea animals
- Researching a sea creature- children's choice
- Information sheets about sea creatures
- Use beebots to get to each creature
