Introduction

Rushton Primary School Nursery is a Governor run. Admissions for this setting are dealt with by the school and not Staffordshire County Council.

Children can be admitted in the term after they become 3 years old.

The Nursery days are Monday to Friday, term time only. The day is split into two sessions. The first session runs from 8.30am until 12.00pm. Lunch time runs from 12-1.00pm and afternoon sessions resume at 1.00 until 3.00pm. Lunch can be provided at an additional cost. Please see Charging and Remissions Nursery policy.

A whole day at nursery will use up 6.5 hours of your child's entitled funding. Any additional hours will be charged at £4.50 per hour.

Families who are entitled to an additional 15 hours of childcare can admit their child into both sessions to fulfill the requirement of 30 hours provision if this is being fully utilised at Rushton Nursery.

It is also possible for parents to subscribe to our Nursery setting and further information is available on request. This service offers a low cost child care option in the following circumstances:

- Children who wish to attend nursery from age 2 but will turn 3 within the same term can apply for a nursery place.
- Children who wish to attend for more than the 15 hours funded provision and do not qualify for the extended entitlement to take them up to 30 hours funded childcare.

It is our policy to try and meet parents' wishes where possible, however in some cases there may be more applications for a particular session than there are places. Places are offered on a first come first served basis.

How to apply

All applications and enquiries should be made through the school office.

Additional Notes

Attendance at the nursery will not guarantee admission to our Reception Class or give any advantage to the child's application for Reception. Parents must reapply for admission to Reception at the appropriate time through their Home Local Authority.

There is no charge or cost related to the admission process of a child to a Nursery.
